**MINUTES OF THE 54<sup>TH</sup> MEETING OF THE STATE GEOLOGICAL  
PROGRAMMING BOARD HELD AT CONFERENCE HALL  
5<sup>TH</sup> FLOOR, DIRECTORATE OF GEOLOGY AND MINING,  
SHIVAJI NAGAR, NAGPUR  
DATE : 10<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2018**

<b>54.00</b>	<p>The 54<sup>th</sup> meeting of the State Geological Programming Board (SGPB) was held at Conference Hall, 5<sup>th</sup> floor, Directorate of Geology and Mining, Nagpur on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2018 under the Chairmanship of Shri S. Ramamoorthy, Managing Director Maharashtra State Mineral Corporation, Nagpur.</p> <p>The list of participants of the 54<sup>th</sup> SGPB meeting is enclosed as Annexure-I</p>
<b>54.1.0</b>	<p>Shri. R. S. Kalamkar, Director, Directorate of Geology &amp; Mining Govt. of Maharashtra and Member Secretary SGPB, welcomed Hon'ble Chairman SGPB and Managing Director, Maharashtra State Mineral Corporation and the members of the SGPB.</p>
<b>54.2.0</b>	<p>Hon'ble Chairman welcomed the participating members and enquired about scope of the Board and how planning is done with regards to items to be taken for exploration.</p> <p>After the formal introduction of members the Chairman asked Member Secretary to proceed with the agenda of meeting.</p>
<b>54.3.0</b>	<b>FOLLOW UP ACTION OF THE 53<sup>RD</sup> MEETING OF SGPB</b>
<b>54.3.1</b>	<p>The actionable point was with regards to planning of exploration programme for F. S 2015-16, so that 2 blocks of Limestone &amp; 2 blocks of Iron ore will be made available for auction under MMDR Act.</p> <p><b>Action</b> :- Exploration in two blocks of Limestone (Kondhala &amp; Dongargaon) &amp; one block of iron ore (Bhisi) completed &amp; the exploration in one Iron ore block (Padve-Mazgaon Dist-Sindhudurg) could not be taken up for want of forest permission.</p> <p>The writing work of Geological report of 1 Limestone (Dongargaon) &amp; 1 Iron ore block (Bhisi) is completed &amp; 1 Limestone block Kondhala is under process. <span style="float: right;"><b>[Action : DGM]</b></span></p>
<b>54.3.3</b>	<p>The actionable point was with regards to monitoring of mining activities in the mining lease areas with the help of data of MRSAC under Geomin Project. Hon. Chairman asked Member Secretary &amp; representative of MRSAC regarding apprehension in putting this data on website.</p>

54.3.3	<p>Hon'ble Chairman enquired with MRSAC, whether MRSAC can help in identifying mining affected areas using technology available with them, so that utilization of funds will be made for mines affected areas only.</p> <p><b>Action :-</b> The Entire database of Master plans of 244 Major Minerals Mines (Excluding WCL Leases) in the State of Maharashtra are now hosted on the Web Geo-Portal by MRSAC. Apart from this the District resources maps prepared by GSI are Georeferenced to the Satellite Imageries. These maps are now made available on the Web GEO Portal by MRSAC.</p> <p>These data bases are of vital importance in the scenario of the e-Governance based decisions requirement.</p> <p>In this regard, such studies are taken up in Chandrapur district as pilot study by MRSAC &amp; DGM jointly. Using the open source very High Resolution Satellite imageries, all the excavations as seen in the District of Chandrapur are marked by MRSAC, using the series of satellite imageries belonging to successive years.</p> <p>MRSAC and DMO Chandrapur have taken up the scrutiny of the mining lease areas of Chandrapur (major &amp; minor) and suggested that the entire district could be classified as mining affected (minor mineral leases included).</p> <p>In absence of MRSAC representative the agenda remained inconclusive.</p>
54.3.4	<p>Shri. Kewal Kishan, Sr. Mining Geologist of IBM requested for constitution of state level committee for scrutiny of mineral concession proposals as directed by Ministry of Mines vide letter dated 06/01/2017. He further requested to send regular information to IBM with regards to status of mining leases, NMET, Auction Blocks etc to IBM.</p> <p><b>Action :-</b> The Committee has been constituted on dated 09/03/2018.</p>
54.4.0	<b>APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF 53<sup>RD</sup> SGPB MEETING</b>
54.4.1	<p>The minutes of 53<sup>rd</sup> meeting of SGPB were presented before the Board for approval. The Hon'ble Chairman asked the Members whether they had any objections/opinion about the minutes presented before the Board. Since no objections were raised, Hon'ble Chairman declared the minutes to be approved and asked Member Secretary to proceed with the discussion on agenda items.</p>
54.5.0	<b>DISCUSSION ON AGENDA ITEMS</b>
